KEYSTONE WOODS WMA GROUNDS RULES (6-1-2024)

MONTHS OF USE JUNE 1 THU SEPTEMBER 13

1. Know the boundaries and always stay in the designated training areas as outlined in the Lease.
2. Encounters with the public must be dealt with cordially and respectfully explaining that the area has been designated /leased for dog training, testing and trailing.
3. The consumption of alcohol is prohibited on the grounds.
4. One article of blaze orange clothing is required during upland training .
5. All trash, including spent shells and dead birds, must be removed from the grounds. Pick up any trash you find.
6. When not being trained, trialed or aired, dogs must be leashed, kenneled or staked out.
7. ATV's are permitted during training following the lease guidelines. (No more than two at any time and no soil disturbance)
8. Motorized vehicles must remain on defined roadways and park in designated areas. No vehicles are to be driven in the fields. Caution needs to be taken during periods of wet/soft roadways.
9. Pigeons, Chukar, Bobwhite Quail, Mallard ducks and Pheasants may be released for dog training. Ducks and Pheasants must have at least an 8 inch colored streamer attached to one leg prior to release. The use of non-toxic shot is required. Live ducks may not be shackled or taped/hobbled.

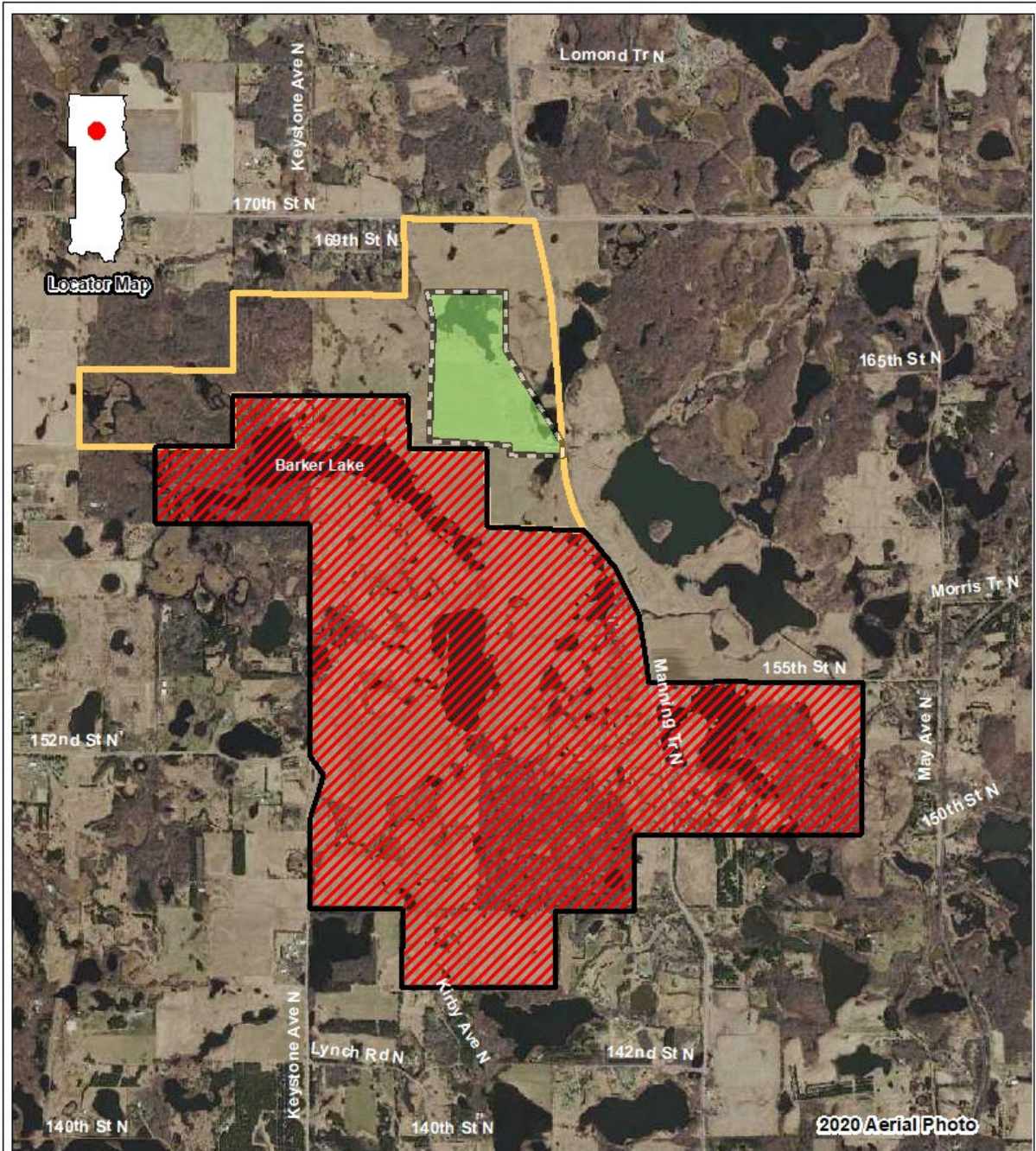

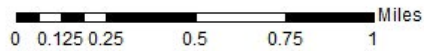
Map
